


New England Fleet: Feeder Cruise to Maine Guide Book

- Moorings may be reserved through Dockwa. There are approximately 20 moorings available, so please reserve as soon as possible. If your vessel requires dockage we recommend the nearest full service facility, Hogdon's (www.hogdonmarina.com), just-outside of-our mooring field. During normal launch hours, the club will provide launch service to BHYC moorings and Hogdon's for events at the BHYC.
- Volunteers will offer you transit to the Hannafords grocery store and Pinkham's for provisioning. Contact Alice or Andy Mutch at 410-353-3861.

Welcome Visiting Yachtsmen,

The Boothbay Harbor Yacht Club Flag Officers, members and staff welcome you to our Club and hope that your stay will be enjoyable. This brochure will explain the services available to you; excellent dining and a full service bar, restrooms and showers, laundry facilities, tennis courts, and visitor parking. We offer morning coffee, which may be enjoyed in the bar area or Casino. WIFI service is free and available in the mooring field as well. We offer daily launch service throughout the primary season, and reduced service after Labor Day. We always have guest moorings available for you!

The BHYC was founded in 1895 and began operations in Boothbay Harbor. The Club became an active racing and social center, with many yacht clubs visiting. In 1938, the Club voted to adopt a 21' class sailboat, The Boothbay Harbor One Design (BHOD), designed by Geerd Hendel. Many of the original wooden boats are sailing today, alongside newer fiberglass models manufactured by local builders. In the 1990's, the J/22 was added as a racing class. The Junior Program was established in 1954, with students sailing in Turnabouts. When the inner harbor became too crowded for Junior racing, the Club leased the former Oak Grove Casino in West Boothbay Harbor, the site of the present Club. The Junior Program today sails both Opti's and 420's.

A new clubhouse was built in 1968, enlarged in 1980, and completely renovated in 2001. It is the center of most activities for our 325 member families. Our campus extends across Western Avenue, where the adult and Junior tennis programs were introduced in 1975. In 1993, the Club bought the neighboring building which today houses the West Boothbay Post Office. In 2002, the Club acquired bordering property on West Harbor Pond that included a home that was remodeled to house Club staff. An adjacent property was acquired in 2011 where the Sailing and Education Center was built in 2018. It hosts the Junior Sailing Program and our Boothbay Region High School Sailing Team.

The Club maintains a prominent role in yacht racing, with a weekly series of races. In 1987, the Commodores Cup series of weekend races was initiated for cruising sailboats. Since 1974, the Club has sponsored a Gulf of Maine Ocean Racing Association (GMORA) Regatta, a two-day event, drawing boats from all over Maine. The classic boat race series has been sailed, since 2009, for traditional boats over 25 years of age. Over the years, the Club has hosted the Maine State Junior Olympics, the State of Maine Opti Championships, and the Sears Cup.

Members participate in a wide variety of events at the Club, but yachting, sailboat racing, and cruising the Maine coast are

LAUNCH SERVICE

From Father's Day to Labor Day the Launch operates every day from 9 AM till SUNSET. Outside these dates, the Launch operates from 10 AM to 6 PM.

Stewards monitor VHF Channel 9 or 3 blasts of your horn.

WI-FI

There are several BHYC networks. The password for all is *guest1895*

DOCK RULES & INFO

- Dockside depth is 14 ft. at low tide.
- Children 12 and under must wear a PFD while on the ramp and floats.
- Swimming is not permitted from the floats.
- Tie-ups at the floats should not exceed 15 minutes without express permission of the Steward on duty.
- Dinghies and inflatables must be tied up on the shore (west) side of the inner floats.
- Water / electric (110 V) are available on the dock.

AMENITIES

- Ice: Bag and block ice may be purchased from the Steward. Visa, Mastercard, Cash, and Check accepted.
- **Showers/Head:** The showers are located on the land side of the Clubhouse and are open 24 hours a day.
- Laundry: A coin operated washer and dryer are located on the backside of the Clubhouse behind the kitchen and are open 24 hours a day. Change is available at the Reception Desk in the Clubhouse.
- Trash: A dumpster is located in the upper parking lot. Please separate cardboard from rubbish.

SHIP'S STORE

The Ship's Store at the front desk carries a wide variety of clothing and nautical accessories. Hours below:

Club burgees may be purchased and worn only by BHYC members. Other items in the Ship's Store may be purchased and worn by both members and non-members.
